PARKING / WALKING NOTES

CONSTRUCTION IS OVER! Park and walk from
any of the named lots below. NOTE: SUNY classes are
in session; lots will be full. Plan ahead!

DISPLAY YOUR PARKING PASS!

PASSENGER DROP OFF / HANDICAPPED PARKING
You can find handicapped parking in lots 6, 9, 10, 22, 25,
and 31 (handicapped permit required). Use the 15-min-
ute-parking-only Lot 10, opposite the front doors of the
student union, to drop off passengers (or instruments).

FROM LOTS 25 and 25A (closest lots to the dining
room): From the corner of lot 25 walk up a steep (but
relatively short) hill to the side door on the right. Once
inside the Union, take the stairs up to the dining room.

FROM LOTS 6 or 9: Park in Lot 6 (behind Kellas
Hall); walk to Barrington Dr; turn right to get to the
Union (or cut through Timerman and Stowell Halls
to come out in front of the Union). Or park in Lot 9,
alongside the new Performing Arts Center and walk
down Barrington Dr. to the Union.

FROM LOTS 20, 22, 31: Lot 22 is behind Van Housen
Ext (where SOAR and the campus police have their of-
fices); Lot 20 is opposite Lot 22, and Lot 31 (always spac-
es there!) is beyond the other two lots. Walk along Water-
town Dr. past Van Housen Ext. and Van Housen Hall; turn
right at the walkway that leads to the side door of Union.
Take the stairs or nearby elevator to the second floor. Walk
all the way around to the back corner on the far side.

ELEVATOR, STAIRS, RESTROOMS

From the front entrance to Barrington Student Union: 1)
take the grand staircase up to the left side of the building;
turn right and walk to the dining room at the back. or 2)
turn into the right corridor, walk back to and through the
alcove leading to the restrooms. The elevator is just be-
yond the "Men's Room." Once upstairs, walk all the way
around to dining room at the far back corner. Handicapped
restrooms are near the entrance to the dining room.
