

Spring 2013 SOAR Course Locations and Parking Info (update: 02-19-13)

SUNY Potsdam – Campus Layout and Parking: www2.potsdam.edu/campusmap *(provides a link to the university's interactive map showing building shapes, names and locations; use tab at top to link to parking map)*

LAYOUT NOTE: SUNY classroom buildings are largely situated in a square, with the library sitting in the center of the inner quad. At each corner of the quad, you will find an open-arched walkway between the corner buildings. You can also “cut through” some buildings to get to the other side; and in many cases walk through adjacent buildings. There is one large open gap in the quad: a statue of Minerva stands there, looking at the main entrance to the Barrington Student Union across the street. Crane Music Center (with its 2 theaters, own library and two classroom buildings—sits in the central area, but across the street from the outside edge of the quad. Maxcy Hall (sports complex) sits at the edge of campus by itself with its own parking areas. The SOAR office—and two of our smaller classrooms—share an office building on the backside of Van Housen dorm (the SOAR office is two floors above the University Police offices). **PARKING NOTE:** Because of ongoing construction, you may find that the lots are full; there also may be detours set up on campus. Please give yourself extra time for parking and walking to class. **(Parking reminders:** write your plate # on the permit; park only where visitors are permitted; always display your permit on your review mirror; your permit is valid through August 31, 2013.)

SOAR Course Locations on the SUNY Potsdam Campus

Barrington Student Union MPR *(second floor; back side)*. Site of the spring luncheon *(parking info coming later)*. Use the main entrance (which faces the statue of Minerva); go straight up the staircase *(taking the left branch)*; to second floor; turn right at the corridor; and walk straight back to the MPR (multi-purpose-room). To use the elevator: from the main entrance, take the right-hand hallway to the restrooms alcove; the elevator is just to the right of the “men’s room” door; once upstairs, work your way back to the front of the building and cross over to the other corridor; turn right, then straight to the MPR.

Flagg Hall 102 *(below ground level floor)*. Park in lot #1 (or #2). Enter the corner archway between Morey and Flagg. Once inside Flagg, veer right, and take the elevator or stairs to the floor below. Walk the length of the hall to find Flagg 102.

Kellas Hall 217 *(second floor; door to room faces lot #6)*. Park in lot #2 (or #6 behind the building). Enter at the corner archway door (from lot #6, enter the back door, turn right to enter Kellas). Take the stairs or elevator (in the Kellas vestibule near the back door) to the second floor; 217 (“distance learning”) is around the corner, the first door on the left. ***Please watch the single step when you enter and exit room 217!***

Maxcy Hall. Park in lot #30 or #27 (**NOT** lot #29, the row closest to the building). Upon entering, **Field House** *(ground floor)* is immediately on the left. To get to Room **104** *(ground floor)*: after entering, bear right and go to far end of the corridor and turn left; **104** is the first room on the right. To get to the **Dance Studio** and **Fitness Center** *(both on 3rd floor)*: after entering, bear right; take first stairs on the left to 3rd floor *(or use the elevator at far end of the corridor)* - the **Dance Studio** is near the parking lot end; the **Fitness Center** is at the far **(elevator)** end of the corridor.

Morey Hall 117 *(windows face Flagg)*. Park in lot #1 (or #2). Enter Morey at the Morey-Flagg corner. Once, inside follow the corridor straight to its end and turn right. Morey 117 is on the right near the end of this short corridor

Satterlee Hall 314 *(3rd floor; windows face the quad)*. Park in lot #1 (or #2). Enter the quad from the Flagg/Morely corner. Enter Satterlee from the quad using the clock tower entrance [**Alternative path:** walk inside through Flagg to Satterly - *involves using stairs*]. Once inside Satterly, use the stairs (in the center or at one of ends of the building); **elevators** are found in the alcoves at either end of the long corridor.

Stowell Planetarium *(basement)*. Park in lot #1 or #2. Go across the quad towards the middle pathway (Barrington Student Union is across the street). Enter Stowell Hall *(on your left)*. To get to the **Planetarium**, pass by 211 *(large Stowell lecture hall on your right)* and continue up a few steps; then take the first staircase to the basement. The Planetarium is at the foot of the stairs, immediately on your right, through an ante-room. (**Elevator** is a bit further down from 211; once in the basement, double back to the nearby staircase alcove - Planetarium is then on your left.)

Thatcher Hall (2nd floor). **Meet-the-Chef: George Arnold** *(Director of Dining Services at SUNY Potsdam)* **Buffet Luncheon**. Park in lot #20, #22, or #31 and walk along Watertown Dr., until you get to Barrington Dr. Thatcher Hall is on the right (before you reach Barrington Union). Take the elevator *(just past the serving area on the first floor)* or stairs to the second floor.

Timerman Hall 121, 123, 131 (ground floor facing quad). Park in lot #2 (or lot #1, or lot #6). Enter the quad from the closest corner archway; make your way around Merritt Hall (or cross on the diagonal) to archway corner to enter Timerman. For room **121** turn right. For rooms 123 and 131 turn left; **123** is immediately on the right; **131** is at the end of the hall.

Van Housen Extension SB27A (ground floor) and **Van Housen Link (“Bubble”) Room** (first floor). Park in lot #20, #22 or #31. Use the door facing the parking lots. **SB27A** is the first door on the right after you enter. For the **“Bubble” Room** continue past SB27A to the end of the corridor; take the stairs or elevator to the first floor (passing by the University Police office; continue into the corridor link beyond where you will find the **Link “Bubble” Room** between the two buildings.

Other Potsdam Locations:

Bayside Cemetery. Located at 730 CR59 (Clarkson Ave.) about a mile southeast of US11. Coming along Clarkson Ave. (from Kinney Drugs), Bayside Cemetery will be on the left (look for a large sandstone building and gateway.) Park/meet at the gate.

Clarkson University (both on ground floor) CAMP 163 (computer room) and CAMP 175 (lecture room). The CAMP (Center for Advanced Materials Processing) building is a huge building on the west side of the **hill campus**. Park in any lot; enter at the main (circular drive) CAMP entrance and continue straight to the end of the hall; 175 opens directly in front of you and the purple atrium; 163 is two doors down the short hall to the left. **Clarkson Hall Therapy Dept.** is on the **down-town campus** (just east of the intersection with Pierrepoint Ave.); it is a newer red brick building located at 59 Main St. Park on the either side of Main St.; there also is driveway-parking at the very back of the building and a very small lot in front of the building. Follow the signs to the Physical Therapy Dept. (in the left wing of building) - take the **elevator** or the stairs to the second floor.

Mayfield Apartments – Community Room. 22 Mayfield Drive (behind stores on Outer Market St., and just off May Road.) The community room is in the one-story office building in center of the circular drive. Park only where you see “VISITOR” (marked on the curb) or in the lot beyond the circle.

Mormon Church – Multi-Purpose Room. (21 Castle Drive). The Mormon Church (Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints) is a large red brick church at the end of Castle Drive which is a dead-end residential street that starts from Leroy Avenue. Park at the farthest end of the building, and enter at the back door (near the kitchen). The dance class is held in the multi-purpose room, located in the center of the long corridor on the main floor of the building.

Potsdam Civic Center (Community Meeting Room on 2nd floor). 2 Park Street (between the Library and Museum). Park behind the building complex (or in any nearby public parking lot). Enter at the back using the Police Station entrance; turn right, go up a half-flight of stairs; turn left and go up another half-flight to the room. (Small **elevator** near the stairs.)

Canton Locations:

Partridge Knoll (Multi-Purpose Room). 30 Sullivan Dr. Large complex, just off intersection of State St. and SH 310 (down the road from Canton schools). Park in front or on the side, but NOT on the lawn! The Multi-Purpose Room is nearest the far left front entrance door to the building.

SLCHA (St. Lawrence County Historical Society): Silas Wright House, County Gallery in the Red Barn Addition. 3 East Main Street (Rt.11). Governor Wright’s white house with its white picket fence sits across from old town park. The red barn addition, parking and main entrance are all at the back of the house. Use Canton Savings and Loan bank entrance on Court St. to get parking. Additional nearby free parking in the lot behind the nearby county building (entrance from Judson St.).

St. Lawrence University (SLU): To get to **Johnson Hall of Science Room 244** and parking from downtown Canton, take Park St. to the far edge of the SLU campus (just beyond the science buildings on the left; sports buildings on right), turn left into very large parking lot J. (Don’t park in reserved spots for faculty/staff (i.e. those spots closest to the science buildings). Walk up the paved path closest to Park St., past Bewkes Hall; turn right and go down the circular drive to the Johnson Hall of Science, the new building sitting angular to Park St. Enter Johnson Hall at the entrance closest to where it connects to Bewkes. Take the elevator or the stairs on the right, near the entrance, to the second floor. Cross over the walkway to the far corridor. **Johnson 244** is on the left, halfway down this corridor. To get to **Hepburn 113**, park in lot J and walk along Park St. to Johnson Hall... (as described above); continue along Park St.; passing several buildings until you get just past Sykes Domitory (a large white stone building fronting Park St.); turn right and walk up the hill; Hepburn Hall (smaller white stone building) is on your left, walk to the front of Hepburn and enter the building. Once inside, **Hepburn 113** is a half flight up, through entrance door, and then turn left. [Alternative path from “J” lot: take the diagonal path, just past Johnson Hall of Science to the core of the campus, passing by Piskor Hall on the left, then the new student union on the right, and Sykes Hall dining entrance on the left; once past Sykes, Hepburn Hall front entrance is your left.] [Alternative parking and (perhaps shorter) path to **Hepburn 113**: Use main entrance to SLU (from Main St.) and park in **Lot H** - next to Vilas Hall (administration) and across from Gulick Theatre; the last few rows are public parking. Cross the open quad diagonally (or walk the paths on two sides of the quad) and you arrive at Carnegie Hall (just beyond the Chapel). The next building beyond Carnegie and set back a ways is **Hepburn**. Enter the closest door (facing you) and go up a half-flight of stairs, go through entrance door to corridor, then turn left for **Hepburn 113**.]

Other Places

Knapps Station Community Church - 3035 CR47. Easiest driving route from Potsdam (if you don’t know the area back roads): take Hwy 56 north from Potsdam to Norfolk; turn right (at the liquor store) onto CR 47; once in Knapps Station, look for the church (on a small rise) on the right (just past where CR48 “T’s” with CR47).
