Spring 2014 SOAR Course Locations and Parking Info (update: 02-21-14)

LAYOUT NOTE: SUNY classroom buildings are largely situated in a square, with the library sitting in the center of the inner quad. At each corner of the quad, you will find an open-arched walkway between the corner buildings. You can also "cut through" some buildings to get to the other side; and in many cases walk through adjacent buildings. There is one large open gap in the quad: a statue of Minerva stands there, looking at the main entrance to the Barrington Student Union across the street. Crane Music Center (with its 2 theaters, own library and two main classroom buildings) sits by itself, across another street from the outside edge of the quad. Maxcy Hall (sports complex) sits at the edge of campus by itself with its own parking areas. The SOAR office—and one of our smaller classrooms—share an office building on the backside of Van Housen dorm (the SOAR office is two floors above the University Police offices). **PARKING NOTES:** Please give yourself extra time for parking and walking to your SUNY classrooms. **Parking reminders:** 1) write your plate # on the permit; 2) park only where visitors are permitted; 3) always display your permit on your review mirror when on campus; 4) your permit is valid through August 31, 2014.

SOAR Course Locations on the SUNY Potsdam Campus

Barrington Student Union MPR (second floor, back side). Site of the spring luncheon (parking info coming later). Use the main entrance (which faces the statue of Minerva); go straight up the staircase (taking the left branch); to second floor; turn right at the corridor; and walk straight back to the MPR (multi-purpose-room). To use the elevator: from the main entrance, take the right-hand hallway to the restrooms alcove; the elevator is just to the right of the "men's room" door; once upstairs, work your way back to the front of the building and cross over to the other corridor; turn right, then straight to the MPR.

Crane Music Center: Hosmer Hall (main auditorium) and Wakefield Recital Hall (second floor of Bishop Hall)-Park in the Hosmer end of Lot #9 (nearest Hosmer Hall). Enter Hosmer Hall by the main doors which face the adjoining parking lot. To get to Wakefield Recital Hall instead of entering Hosmer Hall, stay outside and walk up the long left outside ramp. Once on the seoned level, enter the first door on the left. The entrance to Wakefield Recital Hall is in front of you, just beyond the staircase.

Kellas Hall 217 (second floor, door to room faces lot #6). Park in lot #2 (or #6 behind the building). Enter at the corner archway door (from lot #6, enter the back door, turn right to enter Kellas). Take the stairs or elevator (in the Kellas vestibule near the back door) to the second floor; 217 ("distance learning") is around the corner, the first door on the left. **Please watch the single step when you enter and exit room 217!**

Maxcy Hall. Park in lot #30 or #27 (**NOT** lot #29, the row closest to the building). Upon entering, **Field House** (*ground floor*) is immediately on the left. To get to Room **104** (*ground floor*): after entering, bear right and go to far end of the corridor and turn left; **104** is the first room on the right. To get to the **Dance Studio** and **Fitness Center** (*both on 3rd floor*): after entering, bear right; take first stairs on the left to 3rd floor (*or use the* **elevator** *at far end of the corridor*) - the **Dance Studio** is near the parking lot end; the **Fitness Center** is at the far (**elevator**) end of the corridor.

Morey Hall 117 (windows face Flagg). Park in lot #1 (or #2). Enter Morey at the Morey-Flagg corner. Once, inside follow the corridor straight to its end and turn right. Morey 117 is on the right, near the end of this short corridor.

Satterlee Hall 300 and 314 (both on the 3rd floor) Park in lot #1 (or #2). Enter the quad from the Flagg/Morely corner. Enter Satterlee from the quad using the clock tower entrance Once inside Satterly, use the stairs (in the center or at one of ends of the building); elevators are found in the alcoves at either end of the long corridor. Satterlee Hall 300 is at the right end of the building closest to Flagg; 314 (the art room) is somewhat near the outside end of the building Alternative path: walk inside through Flagg to Satterly - involves using stairs]. Enter Flagg at the outside archway corner and take the stairs (or nearby elevator across from the door) up a half flight to the second floor. Walk through Flagg and enter Satterlee by going into the history of SUNY Potsdam display area. At the far end of the displays, take the elevator or stairs to the third floor. Room 300 (computer lab) is immediately on the left; 314 is on the left, down almost to the end of the long corridor.

Stowell Hall 211 *(main floor)*. Park in lot #1 or #2. Cross the quad, heading towards the middle of the opposite side (toward the statue of Minerva). Enter Stowell Hall (on your left): **211** is the huge tiered lecture hall immediately on your right.

Van Housen Extension SB27A (ground floor). Park in lot #20, #22 or #31. Use the door facing the parking lots. SB27A is the first door on the right after you enter. (This building houses the University Police, as well as the SOAR office.)

Other Potsdam Locations:

Clarkson University: Clarkson Hall Therapy Dept. and *Clarkson Hall Amphitheater are on the downtown campus (just east of the intersection with Pierrepont Ave.) at 59 Main St. (look for a newer red brick building). Park on the either side of Main St.; there also is driveway-parking at the very back of the building, and a very small lot in front of the building. Follow the signs to the Physical Therapy Dept. (in the left wing of building) - take the elevator or the stairs to the second floor. The large Amphitheater is on the ground level.

*Mammoth Lifting. 8 Market St. Potsdam. This fitness studio, with its storefront entrance, is next to Sergi's Restaurant. Park on the street, in nearby lots behind the buildings, or in the "free spots" in the lot across the street from Roxy Theater. (see photos in course booklet)

Mayfield Apartments (Community Room), 22 Mayfield Drive (behind stores on Outer Market St., and just off May Road). The community room is in the one-story office building in center of the circlular drive. Park only where you see "VISITOR" (marked on the curb) or in the lot beyond the circle.

Potsdam Civic Center (Community Meeting Room - on 2nd floor). 2 Park Street (between the Library and Museum). Park behind the building complex (or in any nearby public parking lot, but NOT in the IGA lot). Enter at the back using the Police Station entrance; turn right, go up a half-flight of stairs; turn left and go up another half-flight to the room. (There's a small **elevator** near the stairs.)

*Potsdam Town Hall (Community Room), 18 Elm St. This is a new red brick building on the north side of Elm St. near downtown Market St. There is a small parking lot behind the building; other lots are nearby behind offices and stores. Enter the building either by the front or back doors and follow the main corridor to the room (at the back of the building). (see photos in course booklet)

Canton Locations:

*Cornell Cooperative Extension Farm, 2043B SH68. At the traffic light at the east end of town, turn onto Hwy 68 between the cemetery and The Best Western Inn, and travel a few miles to where the road makes a very sharp curve to the left. The Farm is the large complex on the right side of the road. (see photos in course booklet)

Partridge Knoll (Multi-Purpose Room), 30 Sullivan Dr. This is a large complex, just off intersection of State St. and SH 310 *(down the road from Canton schools)*. Park in front or on the side, but NOT on the lawn! The Multi-Purpose Room is nearest the far left front entrance door to the building.

- SLCHA (St. Lawrence County Historical Society): Silas Wright House, County Gallery in the Red Barn Addition, 3 East Main Street (Rt.11). Governor Wright's white house with its white picket fence sits across from old town park. The red barn addition, parking and main entrance are all at the back of the house. Use Canton Savings and Loan bank entrance on Court St. park behind the building. Additional nearby free parking in the lot behind the nearby county building (entrance from Judson St.).
- *St. Lawrence Brewery, 19 Commerce Lane #4. From Main St. in downtown Canton, head west towards Ogdensburg. Commerce Lane is the next left turn beyond the last traffic light (i.e. where you head south on Hwy 11). This new road on the left lies between the end of a row of older Canton houses and the new Claxton-Hepburn medical offices. The Brewery is the last large building on the right, just before you come to the new St. Lawrence County Jail facility. (see photos in course booklet)
- St. Lawrence University (SLU): Carnegie 10, Johnson Hall of Science 135, and *Newell Fitness Center, Multipurpose Room. To get to Johnson Hall of Science Room 135 and parking from downtown Canton, take Park St. to the far edge of the SLU campus (just beyond the science buildings on the left; sports buildings on right), turn left into very large parking lot J to go to Johnson Hall. (Don't park in reserved spots for faculty/staff (i.e. those spots closest to the science buildings). Walk up the paved path closest to Park St., past Bewkes Hall; turn right and go down the circular drive to the entrance under the breezeway to Bewkes. Once inside, follow the signs to Room 135. Instead of turning left into parking lot, turn right into parking lot D to go to Newell Fitness Center; park behind or on the far side of the complex. and walk around on the far side to the front door. Once inside, walk straight back to the Multi-purpose room. To get to Carnegie 10, park in lot J and walk back along along Park St. all the way past Sykes dorm, turn right and go up the hill, then left on the inner road to Carnegie. Room 10 is in the center of the basement opposite the elevator. [Alternative route to Carnegy 10. Use main entrance to SLU (from Main St.) and park in the back rows of lot H next to Vilas Hall (administration) and across from Gulick Theatre. Walk up the quad past the chapel to Carnegie.

*Yoga Loft (at Maplewood/United Helpers), 205 State Street Road. Follow the instructions to Partridge Knoll, but pass by the entrance road, staying on State St. The large complex nearby is Maplewood. Park in Front. Once inside, go straight past the front desk to the stairs (or elevator) behind in the corridor behind the desk. The Yoga Loft is on the second floor; look for the doorway in the corner by the restrooms. (see photos in course booklet)
