

Spring 2017 SOAR Course Locations and Parking Info (updated: 02-24-17)

POTSDAM LOCATIONS:

SUNY Potsdam – Campus Layout and Parking: www2.potsdam.edu/campusmap *(provides a link to the university's interactive map showing building shapes, names and locations; use tab at top to link to the parking map)*

LAYOUT NOTES: SUNY main classroom buildings situated in a square, with the **Crumb Library** sitting in the center of the quad. At each corner, you will find an open-arched walkway between the buildings. In some cases, you can cut through adjacent buildings. A statue of Minerva stands in an opening, looking across to the main entrance of **Barrington Student Union** (where we have our luncheons). Opposite to the north-east side of the quad (i.e. across from **Kellas**, **Merritt** and **Timerman Halls**, sits the Crane School of Music, with its own library, classrooms, performance areas. **Maxcy Hall** (sports complex) sits by itself with just off Outer Main St. You can find the **SOAR office in room 382 (third floor; just to the left when you exit the elevator)** of **Van Housen Extension**. (The **University Police** is directly below on first floor.)

PARKING NOTES: Please give yourself extra time for parking and walking to your SUNY classrooms. **Parking reminders:** 1) Write your plate # on the permit; 2) Park **ONLY** where visitor parking is permitted; 3) Always display your permit on your rearview mirror when on campus; 4) Your permit is valid through August 31, 2017.

SOAR Course Locations on the SUNY Potsdam Campus

Barrington Student Union MPR *(second floor; back side)*. Site of our end-of-semester luncheons *(parking info coming later)*. Use the main entrance (which faces the statue of Minerva); go straight up the staircase *(taking the left branch)*; to second floor; turn right at the corridor; and walk straight back to the **MPR** *(multi-purpose room)*. To use the elevator: from the main entrance, take the right-hand hallway to the restrooms alcove; the elevator is just to the right of the “men’s room” door; once upstairs, work your way to the other side of the building and head to the back, to the **MPR**. Restrooms nearby the **MPR**.

Kellas 100 *(first floor, end room, closest to Merritt Hall)* and **Kellas 217** *(second floor, door to room faces lot #6)*. Park in lot #2 (or #6, behind the building). Enter at the corner archway door (from lot #6, enter the central back door, turn right to enter Kellas). **100**, a computer room, is the end room closest to Merritt Hall. For **217**, take the stairs or elevator *(in the vestibule by the back door)* to the second floor; **217** *(“distance learning”)* is around the corner, the first door on the left. **NOTE: warning: there's a single step in AND out the corridor doorway!** Restrooms are adjacent to **217**, and also in the basement.

Maxcy 104 and Maxcy Dance Studio. Park in lot #30 or #27 *(NOT lot #29, the double-row closest to the building)*. To get to Room **104** *(ground floor)*: after entering, bear right and go to far end of the corridor and turn left; **104** is the first room on the right. To get to the **Dance Studio** *(3rd floor)*: after entering, bear right; take the first stairs on the left to 3rd floor *(or use the elevator at far end of the corridor)*; the **Dance Studio** is the first room on the right, overlooking the parking lot. Restrooms - use women’s locker room opposite 104 or men’s locker rooms near the entrance to the building; or walk past 104, go up the stairs and find restrooms nearby.

Morey 117: Park in lot #1 (or #2). Walk to the Flag/Morey corner of the quad and enter Morey Hall. Follow straight along the corridor *(passing by restrooms)*, turn right, and walk down to **Morey 117** - the last room on the right.

Satterlee 122 and 225. Park in lot #1 (or #2). Enter the quad from the Flag/Morey corner. Enter Flag *(on the right)* and take the nearby staircase to the second floor; walk to the far end of the corridor and down a half-flight of steps into Satterlee, arriving into the history of SUNY Potsdam display area. Walk through displays (towards Pierrepont Ave.) and take the stairs or elevator to the second floor. Continue down the long corridor, and around the corner, then turn right in the short corridor *(note the restrooms)*. Room **225** *(overlooks Pierrepont Ave.)* is at the end of the corridor. **Satterlee 122** is directly below it *(i.e. behind the old theatre)*.

Van Housen Extension SB27A. Park in lot #22 or #20, if no spots are available, then in lot 31 (a few handicap places are available in lot #21 - the police lot). SB27A is the small classroom on the right, just inside the entrance.

Other Potsdam Locations

Canton-Potsdam Hospital (CPH) *(50 Leroy Street): Conference Room A and B*. **(Parking NOTE:** Please consider car-pooling; lots are often full.) Street parking is also an option. Obey no parking signs! Enter the main hospital door, turn left when you get to the check-in area; follow that corridor straight into the new section; at the very end, take the elevator to the second floor, exit, and walk through the double doors and down to the far end of the corridor. Rooms A/B are on the right.

Clarkson University: Clarkson Hall *(downtown at 59 Main Street): Park* on Main Street or behind the building *(drive-way on the left side)*. There are some handicap parking spots in the small lot directly in front of the building. The **Occupational Therapy (OT) Simulation Lab** is located on the first floor in the wing, closest to the center towards downtown.

Mayfield Apartments: Community Room *(22 Mayfield Drive - just off May Road)*. The Community Room is in the one-story office building in center of the circular drive at the back of the complex. Park only where you see “**VISITOR**” *(marked on the curb)*, or park in the lot beyond the circle.

Potsdam Civic Center: Community Meeting Room *(2 Park Street)*. *(2nd floor of the new addition at the back of the older Civic Center)*. Park behind the building complex or in any nearby public parking lot *(e.g. find free parking sections across from, and behind, the theater)*. Do **NOT** park in the IGA lot! Enter at the back corner doorway. Once inside turn right, go up a half-flight of stairs; turn left and go up another half-flight to the room. There is a small **elevator** in the vestibule downstairs. **NOTE:** Close the inner elevator door as well as the outer door to turn on the light inside; then hit the button.

CANTON LOCATIONS:

Celtic Knot (17 Main St., Canton) Park on (metered) Main St. or behind the store (*there's a ramp at the back door; if needed*).

Partridge Knoll: MultiPurpose Room (30 Sullivan Drive). This is a large senior-living complex that sits far back from the main road. It is just off the intersection of State St. and SH 310 (*down the road from Maplewood and Canton schools*). Park in front or on the side, but NOT on the lawn! The Multi-Purpose Room is nearest the far left front entrance door to the building.

SLCHA (St. Lawrence County Historical Society): **Silas Wright House, County Gallery** (3 East Main Street). Governor Wright's white house with its white picket fence sits across from the old town park. Behind this house is "the red barn addition" and parking. Use the Canton Savings and Loan bank - entrance on Court St. - to drive to in to park behind the SLCHA building. There's also free parking in the lot behind the nearby county building (*entrance from Judson St.*).

St. Lawrence University (SLU) - Take Park St. to the far edge of campus. To avoid getting a ticket, park only in **lot J** (just beyond the science buildings) or **lot D** (*no parking pass needed for lot D!*) behind, and on the far side of the sports complex facing the tennis courts; **lot H** (*next to Vilas Hall - administration building and across from Griffiths Arts Center*) is a bit closer to Richardson Hall and Hepburn Hall, however **lot H** is usually full during the day (*there are several handicap spaces in the front row*.)

NOTE: Hang your SOAR parking pass on the review mirror, so you won't get a ticket in lot J (or H lot). To get to **Brown 141-142** from **lot J**, take the far right steep paved path (*with a sturdy metal railing*) up to the back door of Flint Hall; enter, walk through Flint and out the other end to ascend a half-staircase; turn right and go into Brown Hall; bypass the first long (*windowed*) corridor on the left, make short turns left-right-left into the second long corridor. **Brown 141-142** is the second (*and third*) doors on your left. To get to **Valentine 104** and **Valentine 106**, follow the path described above, but turn left to go into Valentine Hall. **Valentine 106** is three doors down on the right, and **Valentine 104** is two doors down from there. (The "ladies" room is across, the hall in the alcove - the men's room is farther down, around the corner from the vending machines). To get to **Valentine 202**, continue to the end of the hallway, take the staircase (*on the left*) up to the second level; **Valentine 202** is nearby (look for a potted tree!), just before the glassed corridor that connects to Bewkes Hall. To get to **Johnson Hall of Science 112** and **247**, park in **lot J** and walk along Park St., (*past Valentine and Bewkes*). At the circular drive, turn right and walk down to the **first** entrance on the left. **Johnson 112** is about half-way down this corridor. To get to **Johnson 247**, enter the **first** entrance, and walk to the end of the corridor to take the stairs to the second floor. Back-track a couple of doors to find **Johnson 247**. To get to **Piskor 15** (*across from the bookstore*) from J Lot, walk down Park St. turn right, and enter the first end door of Piskor Hall. Descend to the basement - **Piskor 15** is the second door on the left. To reach **Sullivan Student Center 336**, walk past Piskor Hall and take the large pedestrian pathway right, and go straight towards the plaza: cross the plaza and enter the main door of the Sullivan Student Center. Either take the stairs in front of you to the next level (**336** is at the back right side of the staircase), or walk around the stairs on the right to the elevator and take it to "2" (not 2R); Room **336** is the first corner (glassed-in) seminar room on the left as you walk back towards the stairs. To get to **Hepburn Hall**, walk up Park St. past Sykes Residence, turn right and walk up the path to the back of Hepburn Hall (light grey small building left of Sykes) and enter the door that faces Park Street. Go up one flight of stairs and into the corridor. **Hepburn 105** is on your left. To get to **Richardson 015** and **202**, instead of entering Hepburn, keep walking, passing by the side of the chapel to **Richardson Hall** red-stone building (*the original home of SLU*). Take the outside half-flight of stairs (*across from the chapel*), enter, and go **up** one more flight to the second floor; **room 202** is the second classroom on the right. To get to **room 015**, go **down** the half flight of outside stairs, enter, and then, walk to the far end of the corridor to **Room 015**.

SUNY Canton - From downtown Canton, head west on HWY 68 towards Ogdensburg. Turn right at the SUNY Canton stop light and head uphill. To get to ***Neveldine South**, turn **right** at the "V" (large electric sign); pass by some service drives for Neveldine South. Turn left onto Miller Dr. and park in (*unmarked*) large **Lot 1** on the immediate right. (*Do not park in the row adjacent to Newell Vet Tech Center!*) Cross Miller Dr. and walk up the hill to Neveldine South to find **Room 125**. (If Lot 1 is full, drive further on to Miller Campus Center and park in **lot 13**.) To get to ***Roos House, Canton Athletic and Recreation Center (CARC)**, bear left at the "V," drive to the (*bright -blue-at-one-end*) sports complex at the left corner of campus. Turn in, and drive around to the back of the building to park behind in **Lot 23** (*up the hill, i.e. nearest the playing field*). Walk back from the lot to the blue end of CARC, to enter the building. Walk up the staircase to the main floor and up another flight to the Mezzanine - to the semi-open classroom), *or* once you take the first set of stairs up, stay on that level and walk to the front of the building, turn right, go past snack bar and the swimming pool to the "spin room." (Need an **elevator**? When you enter the building, turn left into the coaches area to find it in the first alcove area on the right.)

NON-TOWN LOCATIONS:

Indian Creek Nature Center - Take Hwy 68 from Canton (towards Ogdensburg) for about 3-4 miles to CR14 (it "T's" with Hwy 68). Turn left and head towards Rensselaer Falls. Indian Creek nature center will be on your left in 3.4 miles (the entrance is marked with a large sign).

White Pillars B&B - 395 Old State Rd. (*town of Canton, or if using a GPS? DeKalb Junction*). Driving west in downtown Canton, turn left just over the bridge to stay on HWY 11. Turn **right**, (~ 5 miles down the road) onto Lincoln Rd. (*the crossroad on the left is Eddy-Pyrites Rd.!*). Cross the railroad tracks, turn left at the next intersection onto Old State Rd. White Pillars is well signed and will be on the right about a mile down (2 of their guest houses seen first and then the big white main house).
