NOTE THE LOCATION

LUNCHEON and PARKING NOTES

PARK AND WALK from any lot that allows visitor parking, **Closest lots to Barrington Student Union:** 20, 22, 25, 25A, 31. (There should be plenty of accessible parking since classes are over and most students have gone home for the summer.) **DON'T FORGET TO DISPLAY YOUR PARKING PASS!**

DIRECTIONS FROM LOT 20 (22, 31)

Lot 20 is the large lot diagonally across from Van Housen Extension (the building where the SOAR office - as well as the campus police office - is located). **Walking from Lot 20** (and other nearby lots **22** and **31**). Walk along Watertown Dr. past Van Housen Ext. and Van Housen Hall and turn right at the walkway that leads to the side door of Barrington Student Union. Once inside, follow the directions below, taking the elevator (thru alcove, just past the men's room) or lobby stairs to the second floor luncheon venue.

PASSENGER DROP OFF / HANDICAP PARKING

Use the 15-minute-parking-only **Lot 10**, opposite the front doors of the student union, to drop off passengers (or instruments). You can find some handicap parking in **lots 10, 22, 25, and 31** - handicap permit required.

STAIRS, ELEVATOR, RESTROOMS

Coming in the front entrance to Union, you need to end up on the second floor, back left corner. **Take the lobby staircase** (and the left stairs at the landing), then turn right and walk straight back to the Multi-Purpose Room. **OR take the elevator:** from the front entrance, take the corridor on the right, turn into the restroom alcove; the elevator is just past the men's room door. **Restrooms** upstairs are also near the elevator.
