- -Maintains the account ledger, which includes a complete record of income, expenses, and account balance and is reconciled with the PACES ledger periodically.
- -Supplies a report at each BOD meeting on SOAR's income, expenses, and account balance as well as Expenses by Budget Category using an Excel spreadsheet.
- -As a member of the Administration & Finance Committee, participates in the preparation of the annual budget.
- -Shall furnish the Administration & Finance Committee with the necessary documents, enabling the committee to audit the Treasurer's report and verify, at a minimum, that the account balance as submitted by the Treasurer and the balance as listed by PACES are in agreement.
